Notice Regarding the Filing of a Lawsuit

The article entitled “Acquisition of Suspected Company’s Black Contract with Hirotaka Ishihara”, which appeared on pages 14 through 16 of the weekly photo magazine “Flash” that went on sale March 19, 2013 (the April 2 issue), is a malicious report that is based on a complete misinterpretation of the facts and is contrary to the facts. This report severely harms our company’s social reputation and social credibility, and has caused us to suffer damages such as libel damage and credibility damage. Therefore, Universal Entertainment has today filed a split action for damages (hereinafter, “this lawsuit”) against Kobunsha Co., Ltd., which is the publisher of the weekly photo magazine, and we are providing notice as follows.

1. Court in which the lawsuit was filed and the filing date:

4. Description of the lawsuit and amount of the claims

(1)Description of the lawsuit: Split action for damages based on Articles 709 and 710 of the Civil Code
(2)Amount of the claims: 33 million yen (a portion of the total damages of 103 million yen)

5. Outlook for the future

At the present time, it is not clear if the filing this lawsuit will impact the company’s business, but as the lawsuit progresses we will make a prompt disclosure in the event the business results forecast needs to be revised.
