Regarding Partial News Report

On April 10, 2013, Bloomberg released a biased news report, to the effect that “in papers filed with the Court on the 9th, the U.S. government made it clear that the U.S. FBI is conducting a criminal investigation of Kazuo Okada, the former vice-chairman of Wynn Resorts, who is accused of payoffs to Philippine casino regulators.” Upon our protests and our company’s press release dated April 10, “Regarding Partial New Report”, Bloomberg did an internal review, and as a result, Bloomberg responded that, as Universal Entertainment asserts, the U.S. Department of Justice (“DOJ”) filed a request regarding partially halting the Nevada state court proceedings in regards to the dispute between Wynn Resorts and the Universal Entertainment group. “In their petition dated April 8, the U.S. DOJ referred to the fact that an investigation is underway regarding the donation of \$135 million to the University of Macau Development Foundation by Wynn Macau” was added to the report and the article was replaced on April 11, so we are reporting this.
